

## **Deer Resistant Shoreland Plants**

In some circumstances deer can be unwanted visitors to your shoreland property. This list is compiled of native shoreland plants that are known to discourage hungry deer. These plants can also be planted close to certain plants you wish not to be bothered by the deer. For more information please contact Langlade County Land Records and Regulations Department.

### **Beardtongue (*Penstemon grandiflorus*)**

Sun to part-shade; average to moist soils; 1-2ft.; small white flowers.

### **Black-Eyed Susan (*Rudbeckia hirta*)**

Sun to part-shade; dry to moist soils; 1-3ft tall; yellow/brown flowers.

### **Blue Flag Iris (*Iris versicolor*)**

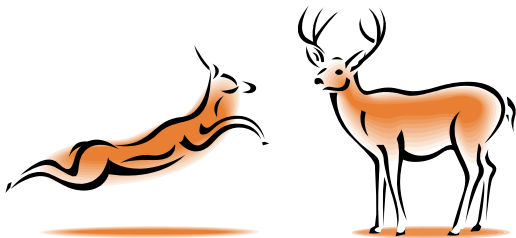
Sun to part-shade; moist/wet rich soil; 1-3ft. tall.

### **Blue-Joint Grass (*Calamagrostis canadensis*)**

Sun to part-shade; moist to wet soils; grows 2-3ft. tall.

### **Butterfly Weed (*Asclepias tuberosa*)**

Sun; dry soils; 1- 2ft.; brilliant orange color.



### **Columbine (*Aquilegia canadensis*)**

Sun to shade; dry to mesic soils; 1-3ft. tall; red & yellow flowers.

### **Dense Blazingstar (*Liatris spicata*)**

Sun; moist soils; 3-4ft. tall; bright purple flowers.

### **Lupine (*Lupinus perennis*)**

Sun to part-shade; dry to mesic and sandy soils; 8-24in. tall; blue to white flowers, early summer.

### **New Jersey Tea (*Ceanothus americanus*)**

Sun to part-shade; well-drained soils; grows to 2ft.; showy-fluffy flowers.

### **Old Field Goldenrod (*Solidago nemoralis*)**

Sun; dry and sandy soils; 1 -1.5ft. tall; yellow flowers, grey stems.

### **Prairie Smoke (*Geum triflorum*)**

Full sun; dry soils; less than 1ft.; showy purple flowers followed by fruiting heads.

### **Purple Coneflower (*Echinacea purpurea*)**

Sun to part-shade; well drained soils; purple petals w/ orange center; 2-3 ft.

### **Rattlesnake Master (*Eryngium yuccifolium*)**

Full sun; moist soils; 2- 5ft.; spindly stem; yellow spiky flower balls.

### **Rough Blazing Star (*Liatris aspera*)**

Sun to part-sun; dry moist soil; 6-12in. tall; yellow flowers.

### **Swamp Milkweed (*Asclepias incarnate*)**

Sun to part-shade; moist, wet soil; 2-4ft. tall; showy pink flowers.

### **Showy Goldenrod (*Solidago speciosa*)**

Part-shade; moist soils; 3-6ft. tall; yellow flowers.

### **White Turtlehead (*Chelone glabra*)**

Sun to shade; moist to wet soils; 2-3ft. tall; white flowers.

### **Wild Bleedingheart (*Dicentra eximia*)**

Part-shade to shade; moist soil; 1-2ft tall; red, drooping, heart shaded flowers.
