

Fox Sedge

Carex vulpinoidea

-Fox Sedge is a lovely wetland sedge that grows to form clumps of 2 feet in diameter by 2 feet tall, thereby making it a very non-obtrusive native plant in your shoreline restoration site.

-In midsummer, the brownish-yellow seedheads spray out from the center to create an excellent effect. Very adaptable, Fox Sedge will grow in a wide variety of moist to very wet soils.

-If you are planning to plant Fox Sedge from seed, plant the seeds fresh, in the fall, or moist stratify the plant in the early spring.
