

Junegrass

Koeleria macrantha

-This early flowering gem produces lustrous silvery-green seedheads in early summer. Junegrass grows 2-3 feet in height on dry sandy and rocky soils.

-Junegrass makes an excellent companion for shorter prairie flowers such as Prairie Smoke, Birdsfoot Violet, Cream False Indigo, and Wild Lupine.

-Plant Junegrass seed in the fall or early spring for the best results. Recommended for dry, sand soils and thin, gravelly and rocky soils. It will not grow in clay.
