

# Pasture Rose

*Rosa carolina*

-If you are looking for a rose that will be a nice compliment to a Swamp Rose, I would like to suggest the Pasture Rose. Swamp Roses have to grow in areas where they can have wet feet (by the shore), but the Pasture Rose does great further inland.

-Pasture Roses grow to heights of 2-5 feet. They do the best in full sun in sandy to loamy soils. They explode with 1 ½ inch blooms throughout June and July.

-Personally, I think the combination of Pasture Rose, Cup-Plant, Wild Bergamot, Oswego-Tea, Black-Eyed Susan, and Butterfly Weed is a knockout.
