

Pin Cherry

Prunus pensylvanica

-I am going to put Pin Cherry in with the shrub selections, although it could be considered a small tree. It can reach heights of 15-25 feet tall. It is going to grow best in areas that are well drained and have a lot of sun.

-Pin Cherry is one of those plants that are great if you disturbed a large amount of land. It will grow quick, but it is short lived.

-I would recommend planting some Pin Cherry in sandy soils along with some Wild Lupine.

-Pin Cherry can make an extremely nice shrub, and it has wonderful characteristics that birds love.
