

# Tall Manna

*Glyceria grandis*

-Not only are the Manna's an important source of waterfowl food and shelter, but in Europe Manna's are being tested as a wastewater treatment plant. Constructed wetlands planted with Manna's have been effective in nutrient absorption and the harvested Manna can then be used as animal fodder.

-If you think that you may have an erosion control problem, plant some Tall Manna, Prairie Cordgrass, and Rattlesnake Manna directly on the shoreline.
